Action: Extend Accreditation to April 30, 2024

A request to the NCAAA by April 30, 2023 is required to initiate a re-accreditation evaluation visit. In preparation for the accreditation visit, a Self-Study Report must be submitted to the NCAAA by September 30, 2023. The re-accreditation evaluation will be a comprehensive review of the program.

The policy of NCAAA is to require all accredited programs to update the program's profile and KPIs annually, and to submit Interim Reports to the Center in order to document progress towards implementing the recommendations of the NCAAA final review report. Interim Reports are due after 2 and 4 years from the date of the accreditation decision.

Areas of special interest in the NCAAA Interim Reporting and in the 2024 re-accreditation evaluation visit will be the program's progress on sustaining the corrective actions reported in the programmatic response to the recommendations.

Disclosure of Accreditation Status

Programs granted NCAAA accreditation may disclose their accredited status in informational or marketing publications, student recruiting presentations, media relations, websites, and other electronic media, using the following statement approved by the NCAAA:
